AUTOMATIC ADVANCEMENT TO THE GENERAL ELECTION

In compliance with Sec. 32-802 & 32-811, Nebraska Revised Statutes, the names of candidates properly filed for nomination at the primary election for the offices listed below do not exceed two candidates for each position to be filled; these candidates shall be declared nominated and their names shall advance to the general election. These names will not appear on the Primary

Nonpartisans - A registered voter who is not affiliated with a political party and who desires to vote in the Primary Election for the office of United States Senator and/or United States Representative may request a partisan primary ballot for any one of the State recognized

Shall the Rosalie Rural Fire District be allowed to levy a property tax not to exceed 6 cents (\$.06) per one hundred dollars of taxable valuation in the General Fund and a property tax not to exceed 4 cents (\$.04) per one hundred of taxable valuation in the Ambulance Fund, which is in excess of the limits prescribed by the law for the 2025-2026 fiscal year and until and including fiscal year 2029-2030 for the purpose of all the general operations of the Fire District
